Literacy

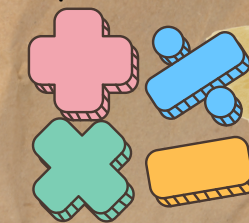
In Literacy this half term, we will be enjoying story writing as part of Book Week, in which we will also celebrate World Book Day. We will also enjoy the book 'If All the World Were', which is a beautifully written poetic story dealing with the sensitive theme of loss in an inspiring and uplifting way.



Maths

In Year 1 this half term we will continue our learning about additive structures to 20 before moving on to subtraction facts.

Year 2 will continue to secure their understanding of multiplication and division before moving on to explore shape.



Spring Term 2

Science

In KS1 our topic this half term is Seasonal Change. We will be identifying the seasons by their features and focussing in particular on the changes that take place between autumn and winter.



History

In History, we will be learning about the life of Rosa Parks. We will use the book 'Little People, BIG DREAMS' as our base text to explore why she is a significant figure in history. Through this, the children will begin to understand how the actions of others in the past can influence modern day life.



EYFS

This half term we will continue learning through exploration, enjoying our daily outdoor and outdoor provision. Children will also begin their Bikeability sessions and we look forward to sharing their progress with you!

Our focus text this half term will be 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' from which we will begin to talk about life cycles.

As always, we will continue to teach our daily Little Wandle Phonics programme. Please continue to support children's reading at home and check Dojo for further updates on how to support your child's progress.



Music

This half term we will be learning about vocal and body sounds.

Through our learning, we will create soundscapes for animals and scenarios.



PE

Our PE session with Hawkes Health continues to take place on Tuesday, whilst swimming lessons will take place on Thursday. All children may come to school on these days wearing their PE kit. They should bring their swimming bag on Thursday, each week.

Art & DT

This half term KS1 are focussing on structures in Design Technology. They will explore stability and stabilising structures with weight, before designing and making their own pencil pot.



IT

KS1 will be learning more about what computers are and how these work. They will explore how computers follow given instructions and identify the different types of computers that exist to help us.



PSHE & RE

In PSHE this half term our focus is 'Keeping Ourselves Safe'.

In RE, we will be learning about the Easter story and why Christians celebrate Easter time.
