Literacy

Maths

In Year 2, children will be exploring addition and subtraction of double digit numbers, as well as learning about money, shape and fractions.

Summer Term 1

Science

In KS1 our topic focus this half term is plants. We will explore the parts of a plant, what plants need to grow and we will name a variety of common wild and garden plants.
