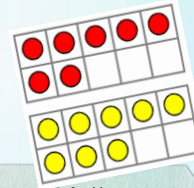

Literacy



Our literacy learning this half term will kick off with some writing based around our trip this week. We will use the trip as inspiration for letter writing and leaflets.

Maths



EYFS: Our children will continue to follow our Mastering Number Programme, working on the basic skills needed to become fluent mathematicians. This will continue to be achieved through daily adult led sessions alongside our daily explore time.

KS1: Our focus this half term in year 1 is about time and measure before we start looking ahead to year 2. In year 2, we will focus our learning on multiplication and division followed by time and money.

EYFS

This term, we start to think about the transition into year 1 and we welcome our new starters into school. We know that our current reception children will be fabulous role models and will make our new children feel very welcome.
