

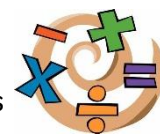
Literacy & Phonics/Spelling

We are starting the term looking at The Storm Whale, focusing on description and vocabulary, we will be writing our own stories based on this. We will also be writing poems for Chinese New Year and writing reports about who is hiding in the river.

Maths

Year 1 will start the term looking at place value and numbers to 20, followed by more addition and subtraction.

Year 2 are adding and subtracting using column methods and crossing the 10s. We will move on to money and then multiplication and subtraction.

Our topic work will be based around water and learning the names of the 5 oceans and 7 continents. We will walk in our local area and visit Whitby in the second half term to find out about the Lifeboat and visit the museum.
