

English:

In English, we will be writing for a range of purposes as part of our topics. Key Stage 1 will be focusing on writing narratives, producing character descriptions using the Rapunzel story and creating an alternate ending to this. Reception children will be enjoying exploring stories relating to family and celebrating their uniqueness with an 'All About Me' focus. All children will enjoy poetry as part of their learning, joining in with and writing familiar repeated phrases.

Maths:

In Maths this term children in key Stage 1 will revisit and secure their understanding of place value. Following this they will move on to apply their knowledge to solve problems relating to addition and subtraction. In Reception children will begin their learning journey into number, investigating and securing their knowledge of numbers to 5. They will use a range of manipulatives to assist in our understanding, such as Numicon and Numberblocks.

Science:

Plants will be the main focus of our science work this half term in key Stage 1. We will explore what a plant needs to grow and survive and will conduct simple tests to investigate this. We will write up and present our findings to the class. All children will also investigate seasonal change and notice differences happening both visually and in the weather and temperature.

History:

The main focus for our topic this term is monarchs. We will investigate Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II and compare life during their reigns. We will also discuss recent events and what this means for our monarchy today.
