

English:

In English, KS1 will be focussing on the text 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London', writing our own stories to reflect this event. We will also be reflecting upon our time in our current year groups and will be writing letters to our teachers in September, introducing ourselves and our intentions for the year ahead.

In Reception, children will continue to develop their independence in writing short sentences and captions. We will focus on the beach, mermaids and pirates as initial themes of interest.

Science:

In Science in KS1 we will continue to develop our understanding of animals, including humans. We will look at categorising animals according to their features and look at the life cycles and the structure of animal bodies.

In Reception, we will look in more detail at how we care for animals and pets.

Maths:

In Maths KS1 will continue to secure their understanding of the four operations through regular opportunities to develop their arithmetic skills. In addition to this, we will be looking at statistics and how to organise data before completing a unit on geometry, position and direction.

In Reception, we will be consolidating the knowledge that we have learnt throughout the year by revisiting this and building upon what we already know. We will secure our understanding of bonds to 5 and 10, solve simple subtraction problems and develop our understanding of shape, pattern and sorting objects into groups.

History:

In history in KS1 this half term we will continue to explore the events of the Great Fire of London. Our topic will end with an exciting surprise on the playground!

In Reception we will continue to focus on change over time, moving on from looking at images of ourselves to looking at how the world changes around us.

Art and DT:

In Art and DT this half term we will be developing our crafting skills. We will look at exploring how to thread, weave and sew embellishments onto fabric.

In Reception, we will continue to develop our knowledge of a range of artists and develop our fine motor skills through wrapping and weaving with ribbons and wool.

RE: This term in RE we will be focussing on how we should care for the world and for other and asking the question; Why does this matter?

PSHE: In PSHE we will be looking at how we grow and change over time. We will explore how we can support each other, both in and outside of school and the changes that we experience as we become more independent.
