

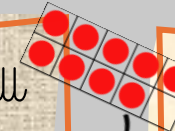


In **Computing** children will learn about how to stay safe online and will complete a unit of work on digital imagery.

In **Literacy** this half term we will be focussing on grammar, punctuation and sentence structure. We will then apply our learning to create a non-chronological factual report about the Great Fire of London.



In **Maths** this half term we will be recapping and developing our knowledge of place value. We will be using a range of equipment to build representations of numbers and secure the foundations of our understanding of number. Year 1 will focus on numbers to 20 and then beyond, whilst Year 2 will work with numbers within 100.



In **Science** we will be completing our 'Animals Including Humans' topic with a focus on people and their pets. Children will group and classify animals and will be able to name different features of animals and humans.



In **Art** this half term our topic is 'Colour Splash!' We will be exploring primary colours and secondary colours as well as talking about the colour wheel, in reference to hot and cold colours.

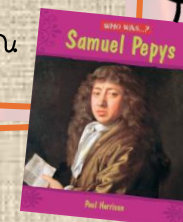


PE will continue to take place on Tuesday and Friday.

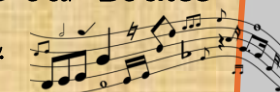
Children can come to school wearing PE kit on these days.



In **History and Geography**, we will be learning all about the Great Fire of London. We will explore a range of texts to find information about this significant event. Our learning here will provide a stimulus for other work in Literacy, Art and Design.



Our topic in **Music** is 'Keeping the Pulse'. We will explore a variety of sounds using different instruments, as well as our bodies and voices.



In **PSHE** we will focus on 'Me and My Relationships', celebrating what makes us unique and how to form positive friendships with others.



In **RE** we will be thinking about what Christians believe God is like, as well as exploring our value for this term, which is 'Generosity'.

EYFS

A huge welcome to all the new families that have joined our class and school. This half term our focus will be on settling our younger children into school life and routine. Children will be given opportunities to explore the classroom and build relationships with others, on a daily basis. As the term progresses, children will explore stories following an 'All About Me' theme, with discussions and activities showcasing their interests and personalities. Children will also explore the world around them, beginning with the familiarity of where they live. In Maths, we will begin our Mastering Number scheme, which develops basic mathematical skills through short, daily inputs and play based activities. In Phonics, children will begin to learn Phase 2 sounds. Initially, children will bring home a sharing book to enjoy. As the scheme progresses, children will bring home a 'Big Cat' reading book.
